This year marked the 102nd season of baseball and softball for the Cleveland Baseball Federation (CBF). We provided for over 200 teams this year, ranging from t-ball through high school baseball and softball. That is over 3,500 City of Cleveland youth that played in our league, free of charge!

CBF had the tremendous opportunity to host the 2012 RBI East Regional Tournament this summer as well. This was the first time in 15 years that Cleveland hosted the RBI Tournament. We had 13 teams from Cleveland, Cincinnati, Detroit and Indianapolis compete in this year's tournament for the right to advance to the RBI World Series in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Championship games were played on Sunday July 22nd, with the girls playing at Case Western Reserve's Mather Park and the boys playing at Progressive Field. The Cleveland RBI Girls Softball team defeated the Cincinnati Reds RBI Softball team in the championship game to advance to the RBI World Series. This marked the 4th consecutive year the team from Cleveland has advanced!
